And now imagine ...


... what would happen if we can connect the IT solutions of our business partners as easy as sticking a plug into a socket!

- ACRIS (Aviation Community Recommended Information Services) is a working group of the ACI World IT Standing Committee
- ACRIS was established in 2009
- Open for all interested stakeholders in the aviation industry








ACI ACRIS in a nutshell


- Vision: "The consistent adoption of Service Oriented Architecture (SOA) principles across the world's Airport Community in a coordinated effort".
- Mission: "To deliver recommendations, requirements and technical specifications to implement the ACI ACRIS Vision".
- Main objective: "Define a framework for airports, airlines, partners and suppliers to facilitate cross-company process integration scenarios (B2B)".
- Doing so ACRIS uses existing standards (e.g. AIDX, ...) and strongly collaborates with community partners as IATA, Eurocontrol, ...
- Methodically ACRIS follows a model-driven approach supported by the ACRIS Semantic Model Community of Practice





ACRIS business drivers









ACRIS deliverables

Major deliverable of the ACRIS WG is the Recommended Practice (RP502A10) approved by ACI World. RP covers for example ...

- the management of ACRIS Service descriptions,
- the roles and responsibilities of Service Consumers and Providers,
- best practices for bilateral service agreements.

Standardized WebService descriptions (approved by the WAITSC) are attached to the RP as annex.





ACRIS projects


- The development of WebService Descriptions (XSD/WSDL) for B2B scenarios is organized in projects. For example:
 - Baggage and Passenger Conformance WebServices (V 2.0 available)
 - A-CDM Common Situational Awareness WebServices (V 1.0 available)
 - Asset Management WebServices (work ongoing)
 - Seamless Travel WebServices (work ongoing)
 - ... others to come!





ACRIS project: Baggage and Passenger Conformance

- Cooperation with IATA CUWS
- Working with ACRIS Semantic Model framework
- Business Req. Doc. accepted by IATA and ACI in Sep '13
- IATA RP1741 approved Nov '13 by JPSC → Web Services recommended for Bag Drop to airline DCS integration
- WSDL released Mar '14 by IATA and ACI








ACRIS project: A-CDM Common Situational Awareness

Number of A-CDM initiatives increase all over the world

(e.g. only in Europe min. 24 airports)

 → Number of Common Situational Awareness (CSA) Portals increase
 → Problem for airlines et al

- Successful ACRIS PoC in Q1 '12
- PoC version 1.0 of WebService used in OSL operationally!
- Version 2.0 under development in cooperation with SESAR








ACRIS A-CDM CSA Operational Services (AACO)

- Background:
 - Successful ACRIS PoC in Q1 '12
 - Cooperation with EuroControl in SESAR
- State-of-play:
 - PoC version (V1.0) used in OSL operationally!
 - V2.0 under development in cooperation with SESAR (SES ATM Research Project)
 - Logical definition of Web Services exist
 - XML Payload based on FIXM 2.0 exist (by E'CTRL)
 - XML Payload based on latest AIDX to be developed (by ACRIS WG)
 - Refactoring of Services discussed and decided in FRA on 23rd of September
 - WSDL, XSD (based on AIDX), and implementation guide to be developed by Lockheed Martin until end of 2014.







ACRIS Semantic Model Community of Practice

- Background:
 - Part of ACRIS since 2010
 - ACRIS promotes a model driven architecture and development approach, supported by the ACRIS Semantic Model
 - The ACRIS Semantic Model Community of Practice (ASMCoP) maintains this model
- State-of-play:
 - New repository (SharePoint server, sponsored by LHR) providing all parts and elements of the ACRIS Semantic Model was introduced by the ASMCoP Chairman in FRA on Sep 23rd.
 - ACRIS WG decided to use this platform on short notice for all ACRIS documents, meeting minutes, presentations, ... <u>until ACI World will provide a collaboration platform for all committees and working groups</u>.





New projects

- Asset Management
 - Background:
 - Project idea by LHR and Siemens
 - WebServices for the management of facility assets and technical assets
 - State-of-play:
 - First draft of project definition discussed in FRA.
 - Further need for focusing in scope → to be discussed in the next meeting
- Seamless Travel
 - Background:
 - Project idea by MUC
 - WebServices for the provisioning of services to passengers (e.g. via mobile apps) over the whole passenger process (B2C scenario !!!)
 - State-of-play:
 - On hold: MUC to reviews the whole concept. ACRIS relevance to be discussed in the next ACRIS meeting





Even good things can get better – ACRIS reloaded!

- The ACRIS working group performed some very successful projects:
 - ACRIS PoC in the area of A-CDM Common Situational Awareness.
 - Project on "Baggage and Passenger Conformance Services" in collaboration with IATA
 - Project on "A-CDM CSA Operational WebService (AACO)" in collaboration with SESAR Fast Track 10
- Beside the excellent deliverables of these projects, the ACRIS WG gained some very fruitful experience that should be used to make ACRIS more efficient and successful.
- Therefore the following slides present fields of improvement based on an analysis of what we have done so fare and where we are today.
