SUBJECT Computer Based Training (CBT) Rollout for Badge Icons

As a follow up to the memo sent October, 2019 regarding Computer Based Training (CBT), all LAWA employees will be required to utilize the eLearning portal (<u>www.lawatraining.org</u>) for the Restricted Area Driver (RAD) and the AOA Familiarization (AOA) icon courses beginning March 2, 2020. There will be no change to the Air Traffic Control (ATC) course procedures and the Aircraft Surface Movement (ASM) course is for tenants only. All LAWA Authorized Signers will be notified via email by February 3, 2020 with instructions on how to create and edit employee profiles.

Also as of March 2, 2020, the RAD icon will no longer be automatically rolled over at each badge renewal for LAWA employees. Those who have the RAD icon will be required to take the CBT RAD course and test every 24 months prior to each badge renewal. LAWA employees obtaining a RAD icon for the first time will also need to complete the CBT RAD course and on-line test. The additional requirement to complete 8-hours of behind-the-wheel training does not change.

Each employee will be required to bring their respective printed and signed (by an Authorized Signer) course completion certificates to their badge renewal. Employees who require the AOA Familiarization Icon must present their AOA certificate to the Airport Operations front desk staff on the 2<sup>nd</sup> floor to receive the AOA stamp on the badge application. For RAD, the certificate must be submitted to the Security Badge Office (SBO) upon check-in.
