




TERMINAL B: AIR FRANCE NEW LOUNGE NOW OPEN






CONSTRUCTION HOTTOPICS

TERMINAL 2 ARRIVALS LEVEL CURBSIDE **BARRICADES REMOVED**

Minimal construction barricades remain inside the terminal and will be removed as work completes.












#3 **COMPLETED: EB CENTURY BLVD** LANE RESTRICTIONS

LANE RESTRICTIONS

THE MAP BELOW IS A COLLECTIVE SNAPSHOP OF ALL SCHEDULED 24/7 LANE RESTRICTIONS FOR CTA DEPARTURES AND ARRIVALS LEVEL ROADWAYS FOR THE MONTH OF JUNE 2024.

PI FASE NOTE:

This map only reflects 24/7 continuous lane closures in the CTA: other nightly lane closures / sidewalk restrictions may be in place to facilitate construction activities

ACCESS MAINTAINED:

Traffic around the Central Terminal Area will be maintained at all times, as well as access to passenger pick-up and drop-off
