


Construction Hot Topics

Week of January 28 – February 1, 2019

1. UPDATE: Arrivals Level Lane Restrictions at Terminal 2

- All Arrivals Level inner lanes at Terminal 2 (between Columns 2H & 2K) are closed continuously through February 28, 2019 for work related to the LAWA Utilities and LAMP Enabling Project
- The Rental Car Shuttle Stop and Taxi Zone are also closed
- Detour signage is in place to direct pedestrian and vehicular traffic

2. UPDATE: Departures Level Lane Restrictions between Terminals 1 & 2

- A temporary pedestrian walkway has been built over the Departures Level pick-up lane between Terminals 1 and 2 as part of the Terminal 1.5 Site Improvements project
- The walkway will be in place (and the innermost lane closed) through March 2020



3. Terminal B: New Construction Barricade

- A new barricade is in place on the Departures Level in Terminal B, against the east wall, for construction on a retail store
- Additional barricades can be expected at this area over the coming months
- All work at this area is expected to be complete by August 2019

4. UPDATE: Extended – Gate 21B Closure

- Work to install a new Passenger Boarding Bridge at Terminal 2, Gate 21B, has been extended through April 2019
- While no flights will arrive or depart from Gate 21B during this time, all work is airside and the hold room / seating remain available to guests



5. Terminal 4: Barricade Status


- Barricading is complete at Terminal 4 – Arrivals Level for American Airlines’ Baggage Claim Modifications project; it is scheduled to be in place through May 2019
- Next, barricading will receive a “coming soon” graphic

6. Terminal 5: Barricade Status

- Barricading is complete at the east end of Terminal 5 for American Airlines’ Ticket Lobby Improvements project; next, barricading will receive a “coming soon” graphic
- Additional barricades are being constructed at the west end of Terminal 5, Ticketing, this week
- All barricading is scheduled to be in place through May 2019
