TAXILANE D8 PUSH-BACK OPERATIONS DURING CONSTRUCTION

To enhance safety and minimize the potential impact from break-away jet blast, all aircraft departing from the D8 Taxilane between Terminal 1 & 2 will need to be towed to the top of the Taxilane for aircraft disconnect and taxi. This procedure is meant to ensure that the breakaway jet blast is kept to a minimum and far enough from the construction area at the bottom of the Taxilane. This procedure will be in effect from Monday, August 27th, 2018 until June of 2019.
