### TERMINAL 4: PEDESTRIAN BRIDGE DEMOLITION

Demolition of the pedestrian bridge between Terminal 4 and Parking Structure 4 will continue this week, with work to remove the bridge scheduled during limited overnight hours. Please continue to watch for posted signage as work progresses, use caution when navigating near construction areas, and plan ahead for potential delays.

### DELTA ONE LOUNGE NOW OPEN

The new Delta One Lounge has opened in Terminal 3, near the existing Delta SkyMiles Club. Passengers with a Delta One ticket, 360 Status, or equivalent class seat on partner airlines are eligible to enter. It features food, a bar, WiFi throughout, a wellness area, and a sky deck that overlooks flights departing and arriving on the north runways. The new Delta One Lounge is open seven days a week from 4:30AM to 11:30PM.

### TERMINAL 3: DEPARTURES LEVEL TEMPORARY SIDEWALK EXTENSION REMOVED

Work to remove the temporary sidewalk extension and protective pedestrian canopy along the Departures Level curbside at Terminal 3 is complete. Guests are now routed back to the existing sidewalk and vehicular traffic has re-opened for the innermost drop-off lane.



### PLEASE NOTE:

Curbside barricades remain in place on both the Departures and Arrivals Levels between Terminal 3 and Terminal B ("North Knuckle") for construction at the plaza area through the end of 2024. Watch Construction Hot Topics for more information.

### PLEASE NOTE:

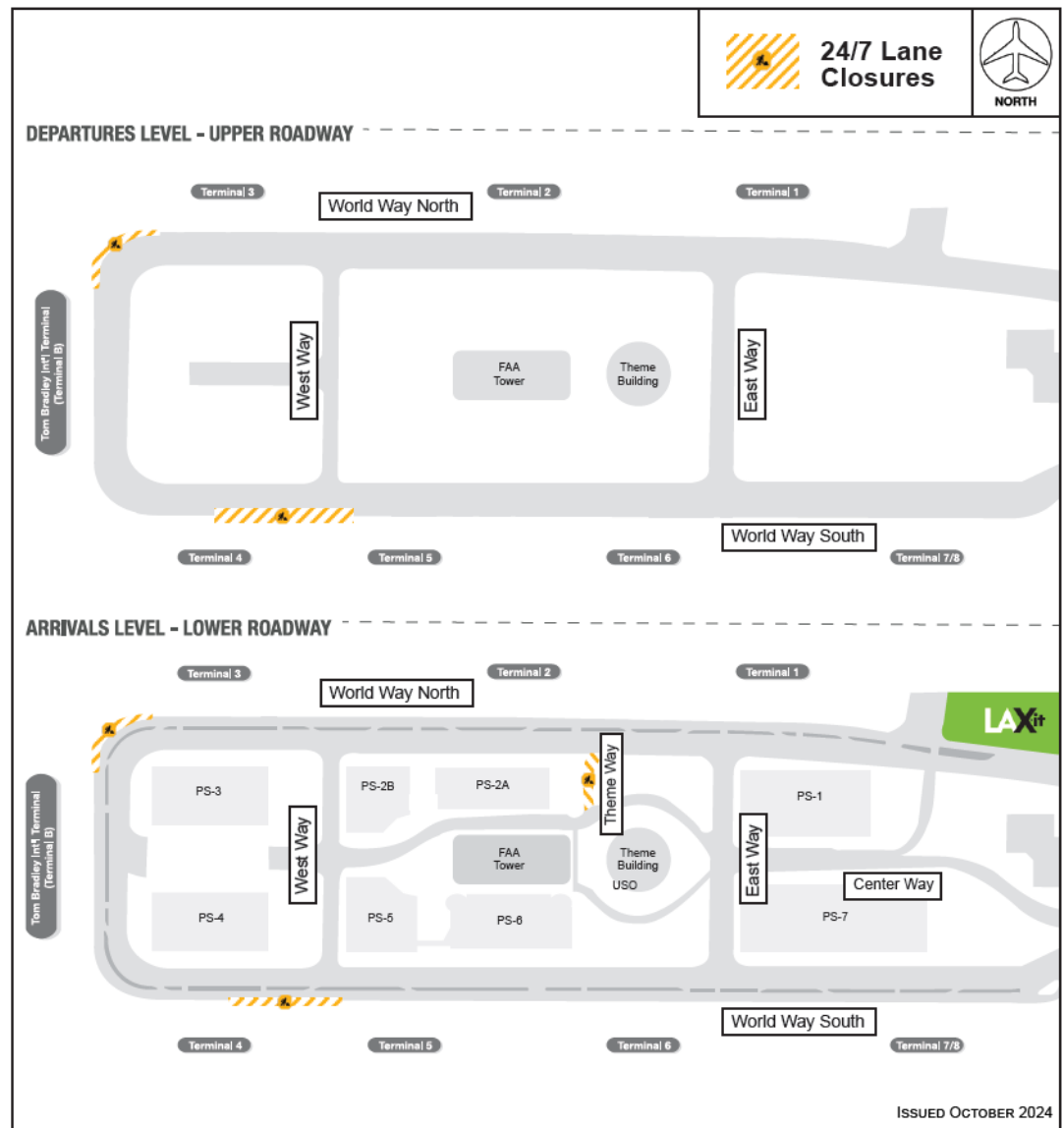
This map only reflects 24/7 continuous lane closures in the CTA; other nightly lane closures / sidewalk restrictions may be in place to facilitate construction activities.
