

## **#1** TERMINAL 4: NEW CURBSIDE BARRICADES

To facilitate work for the American Airlines Terminal 4/5 Modernization Program, new construction barricades are scheduled to be built curbside on the Arrivals Level at Terminal 4. The curbside barricades will encompass the existing sidewalk, requiring the closure of the inner lane to be used as a temporary pedestrian walkway - similar to the curbside barricades that were recently removed from between Terminals 4 & 5.

Following the completion of this barricade, work will progress to building a similar barricade on the Departures Level, where the inner lane will also be used for a temporary pedestrian sidewalk. Watch Construction Hot Topics for updates on this and other construction projects.

## **#2** TERMINAL 4: AIRLINE GATE IMPACTS

To facilitate construction for the American Airlines Terminal 4/5 Modernization Program, the following Airline Gate impacts will take place in Terminal 4 (map pictured right) throughout January 2025:

Gates 42B, 45 & 46A: Close on Tuesday, Jan. 7 through Apr. 20, 2027

\*Interior holdrooms will not be available at the gates listed above. Construction will close the central portion of the concourse; guests will be detoured to Level 1 to reach open airline gates at the south end of the concourse.

Gate 47A: Reopens on Tuesday, Jan. 7; closed since Oct. 3, 2024

Next month, the following Airline Gate impacts are scheduled to occur in Terminal 4:

Gate 43: Closes on Monday, Feb. 10 through Aug. 29, 2025 Gate 47B: Reopens Monday, Feb. 10; closed since Oct. 3, 2024

Signage will be posted alerting guests of all detour routes to access open gates throughout this next phase of construction in Terminal 4.

### **#4** JANUARY 2025: 24/7 CTA LANE RESTRICTIONS

The map below is a collective snapshot of all scheduled 24/7 lane restrictions for CTA Departures and Arrivals Level Roadways for the month of January 2025.

This map only reflects 24/7 continuous lane closures in the CTA; other nightly lane closures / sidewalk restrictions may be in place to facilitate construction activities.
