




HAWAIIAN AIRLINES: RELOCATING OPERATIONS FROM TERMINAL B TO TERMINAL 6


PARKING STRUCTURE 7: STAIRWELL PAINTING

LAWA Paint Crew will be refreshing three stairwells on the south side of Parking Structure 7 beginning Monday, April 21 through Friday, July 18. Only one stairwell will be closed at a time (continuous 24/7 closure) while work is completed per the following schedule:

- Stair 8 (Southeast): Monday, April 21 Tuesday, May 20
- Stair 4 (South): Wednesday, May 21 Wednesday, June 18
- Stair 2 (Southwest): Friday, June 20 Friday, July 18


Signage will be posted alerting pedestrians of closed stairwells and alternate routes.

Please note: Stair 6 (South) is not included in this work as the APM Project has already completed painting of this staircase; North Stairs 3 & 5 are currently for Emergency Exit Only due to ongoing construction along Center Way.


TERMINAL B: NEW BARRICADES COMPLETE

APRIL 2025: 24/7 CTA LANE RESTRICTIONS

Here is a collective snapshot of scheduled 24/7 lane restrictions for CTA Departures and Arrivals Level Roadways for the month of April 2025.

This map only reflects 24/7 continuous lane closures in the CTA; nightly lane / sidewalk restrictions may be in place to facilitate construction activities.

Traffic around the Central Terminal Area will be maintained at all times, as well as access to passenger pick-up and drop-off and ingress to / egress from parking structures.

Motorists should plan ahead for potential delays and use caution when traveling near construction areas.
