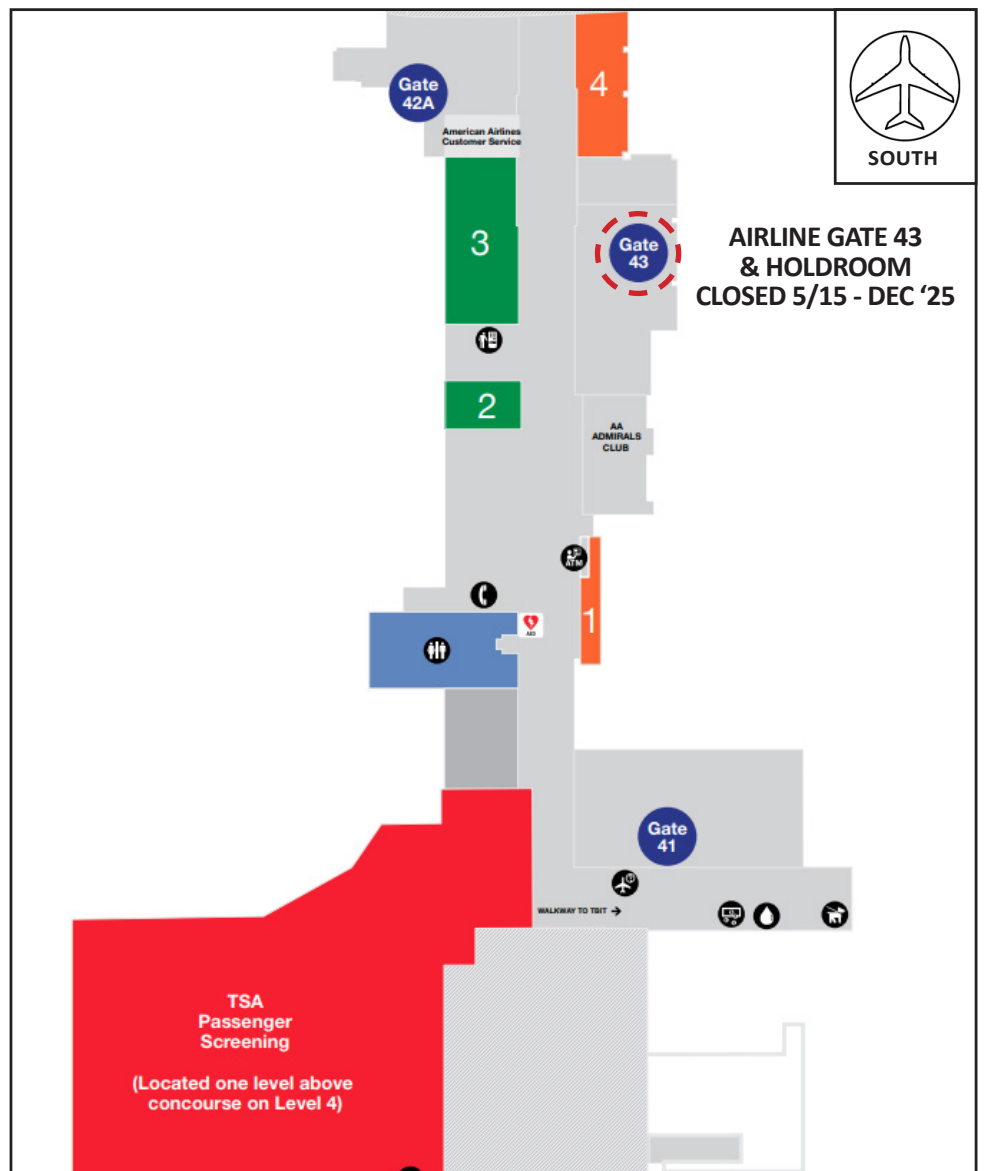
TERMINAL 4: AIRLINE GATE 43 & HOLDROOM CLOSED

To facilitate holdroom renovations as part of the American Airlines Modernization Program, Airline Gate 43 and the adjacent holdroom in Terminal 4 are scheduled to be closed effective Thursday, May 15 through December 2025.

Construction barricades will be installed at the Gate 43 holdroom area while construction takes place.

As a reminder, the central portion of the Terminal 4 Concourse remains closed for construction, with guests accessing south gates via the underground Arrivals Tunnel.

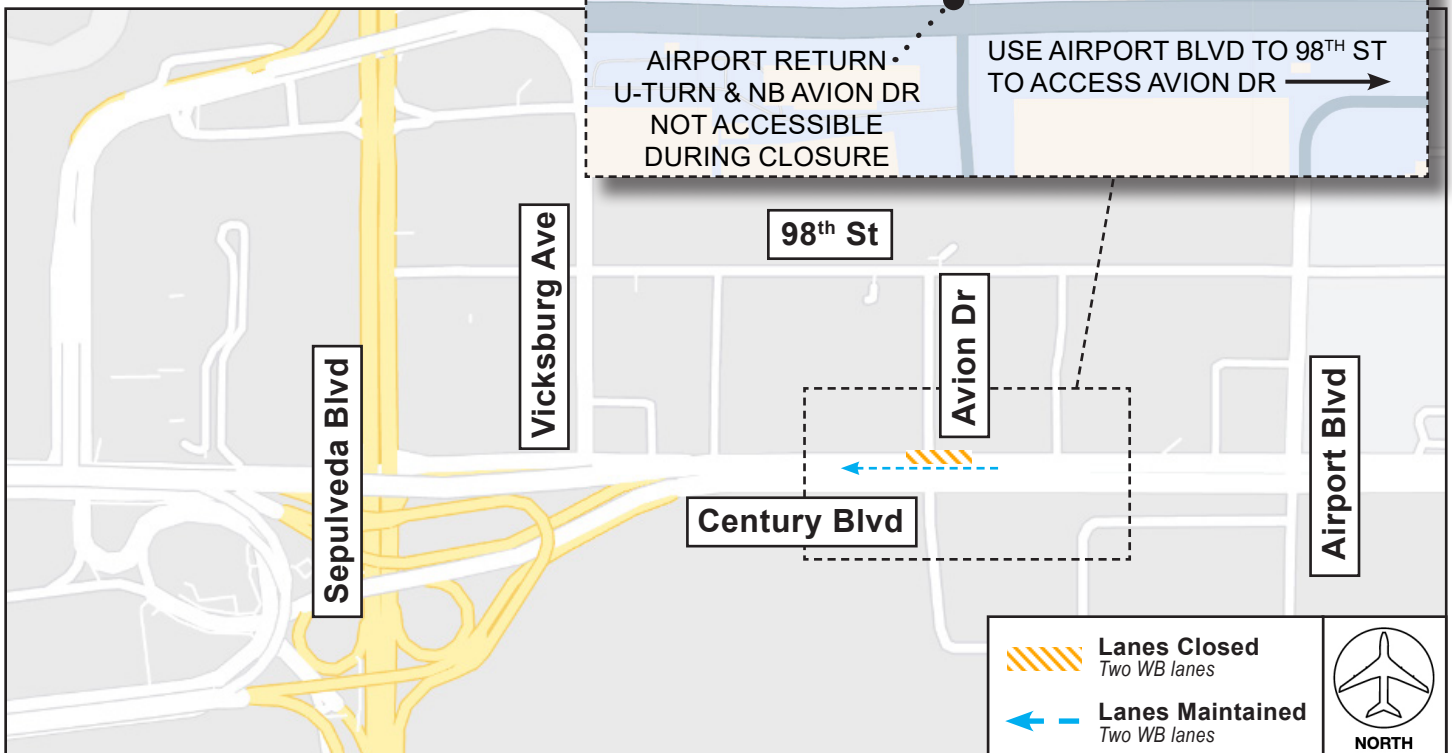

WB CENTURY BLVD: TWO LANE CLOSURE 5/16 - 5/19

To facilitate roadway paving for the Automated People Mover Project, two westbound lanes on Century Boulevard at Avion Drive will be closed Friday, May 16 at 12AM through Monday, May 19 at 5AM with two westbound lanes remaining open at all times.

Avion Drive north of Century Boulevard will not be accessible by vehicle from this intersection; please use Airport Boulevard to 98th Street to reach Avion Drive. Eastbound Century traffic will not be affected, but the "Airport Return" U-turn at Avion Drive will be unavailable to reach westbound Century Boulevard. The north/south pedestrian crosswalk across Century Boulevard will also be closed.

MAY 2025: 24/7 CTA LANE RESTRICTIONS

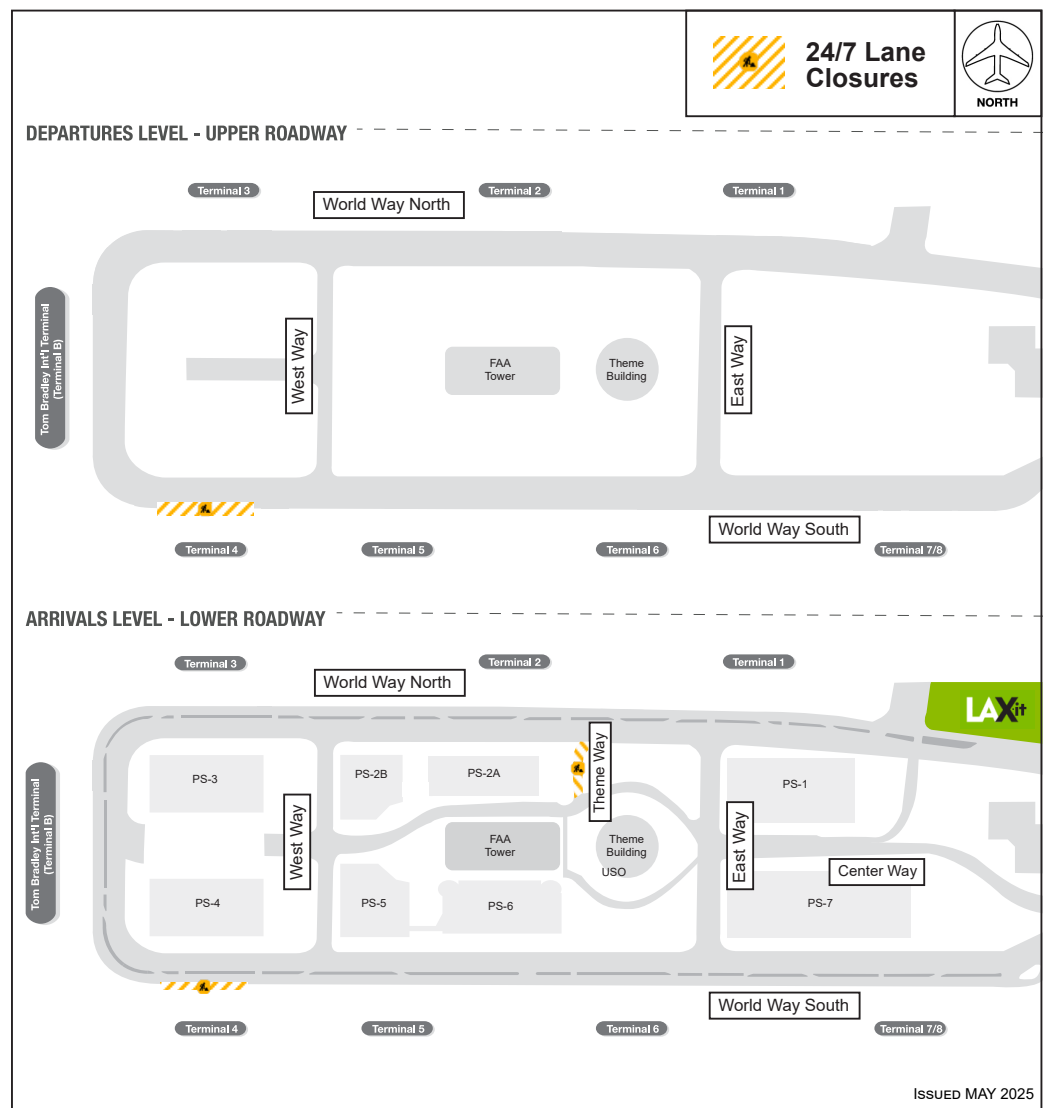
Here is a collective snapshot of scheduled 24/7 lane restrictions for CTA Departures and Arrivals Level Roadways for the month of May 2025.

This map only reflects 24/7 continuous lane closures in the CTA; nightly lane / sidewalk restrictions may be in place to facilitate construction activities.

Traffic around the Central Terminal Area will be maintained at all times, as well as access to passenger pick-up and drop-off and ingress to / egress from parking structures.

Motorists should plan ahead for potential delays and use caution when traveling near construction areas.
