



PARKING STRUCTURE 3 & 4 IMPROVEMENTS

As part of the Automated People Mover project, Parking Structures 3 & 4 will undergo garage improvements throughout April 2025. Work will occur during limited daytime hours on all levels of both structures and will include maintenance work such as wall painting in advance of future wayfinding signage and graphics installation.

Both structures will remain open and operational during this work, including ingress to and egress from both structures. Some parking stalls will be unavailable; signage will be posted alerting vehicles of any parking restrictions, and flaggers will be in place when necessary to assist with wayfinding and the flow of traffic.

APRIL 2025: 24/7 CTA LANE RESTRICTIONS


Here is a collective snapshot of scheduled 24/7 lane restrictions for CTA Departures and Arrivals Level Roadways for the month of April 2025.

This map only reflects 24/7 continuous lane closures in the CTA; nightly lane / sidewalk restrictions may be in place to facilitate construction activities.

Traffic around the Central Terminal Area will be maintained at all times, as well as access to passenger pick-up and drop-off and ingress to / egress from parking structures.

Motorists should plan ahead for potential delays and use caution when traveling near construction areas.
