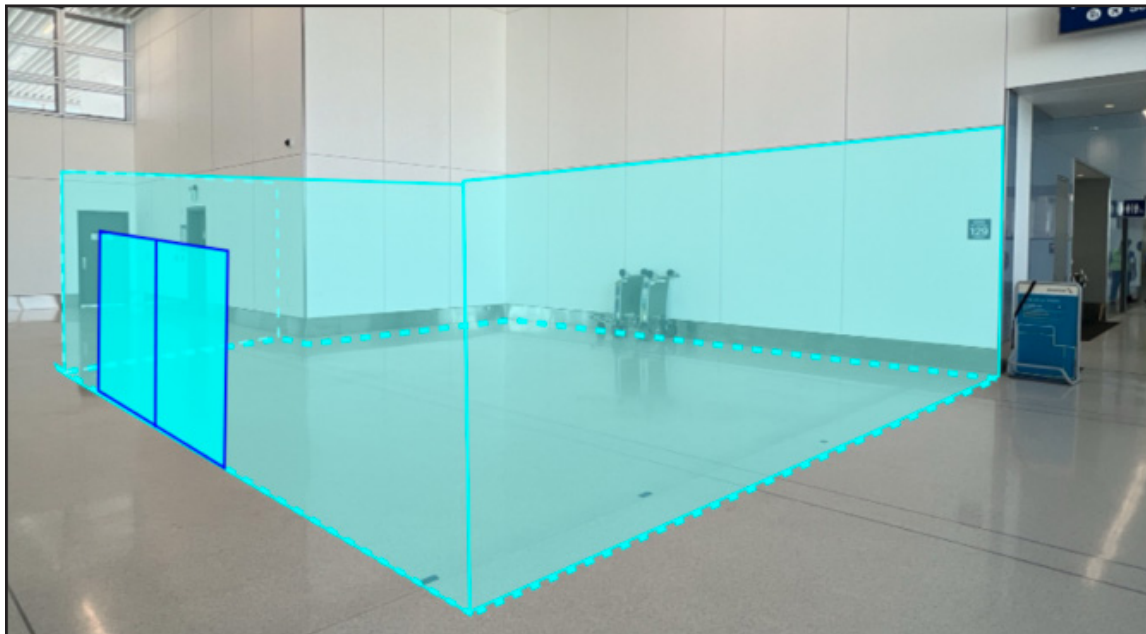
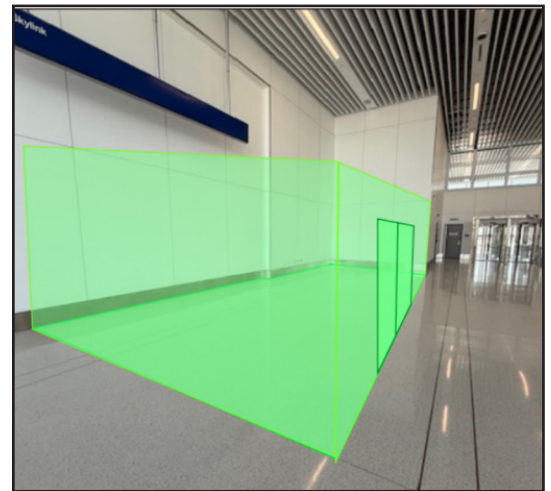

## RELOCATION OF TERMINAL 5 CREDIT UNION

To facilitate Terminal 5 Enabling work required for future construction activities, the existing Credit Union in Terminal 5 will be relocated to Level 4 of the Terminal 4.5 Core (area between Terminal 4 & Terminal 5).

Construction barricades will be installed at two locations on T4.5 Level 4 (pictured). Work outside of these barricades will be restricted to limited overnight hours between 11PM and 4AM to reduce impacts to guests and employees. This work is expected to be complete in October 2025.

## MAY 2025: 24/7 CTA LANE RESTRICTIONS

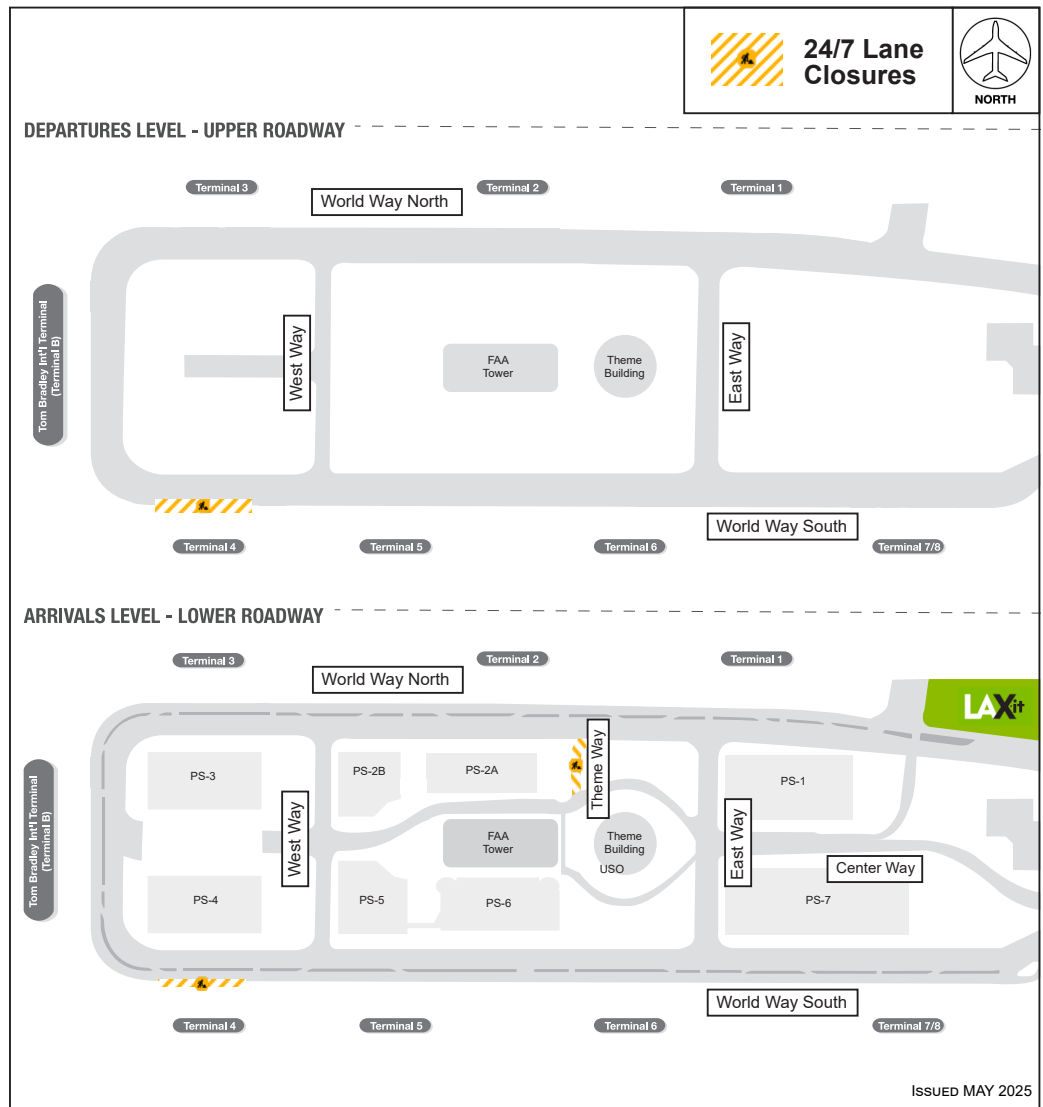
Here is a collective snapshot of scheduled 24/7 lane restrictions for CTA Departures and Arrivals Level Roadways for the month of May 2025.

This map only reflects 24/7 continuous lane closures in the CTA; nightly lane / sidewalk restrictions may be in place to facilitate construction activities.

Traffic around the Central Terminal Area will be maintained at all times, as well as access to passenger pick-up and drop-off and ingress to / egress from parking structures.

Motorists should plan ahead for potential delays and use caution when traveling near construction areas.
