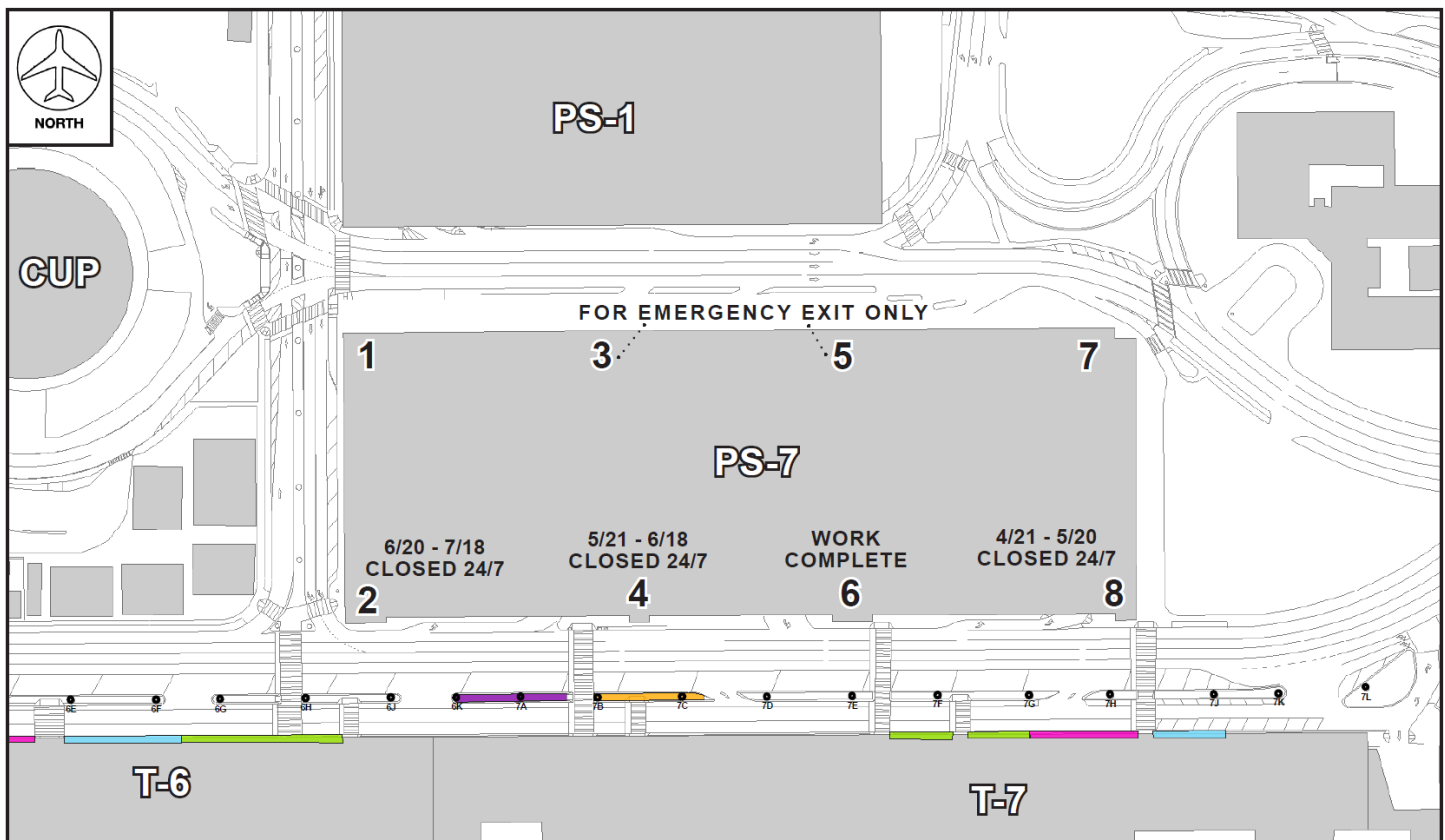

### PARKING STRUCTURE 7: SOUTH STAIR REFRESH

LAWA Paint is refreshing three stairwells on the south side of Parking Structure 7 ongoing through Friday, July 18. Only one stairwell will be closed at a time (24/7 closure) while work is completed per the following schedule:

- Stair 8 (Southeast): Monday, April 21 - Tuesday, May 20 **\*DONE\***
- Stair 4 (South): Wednesday, May 21 - Wednesday, June 18 **\*DONE THIS WEEK\***
- Stair 2 (Southwest): Friday, June 20 - Friday, July 18 **\*STARTING THIS WEEK\***

Signage will be posted alerting pedestrians of closed stairwells and alternate routes.

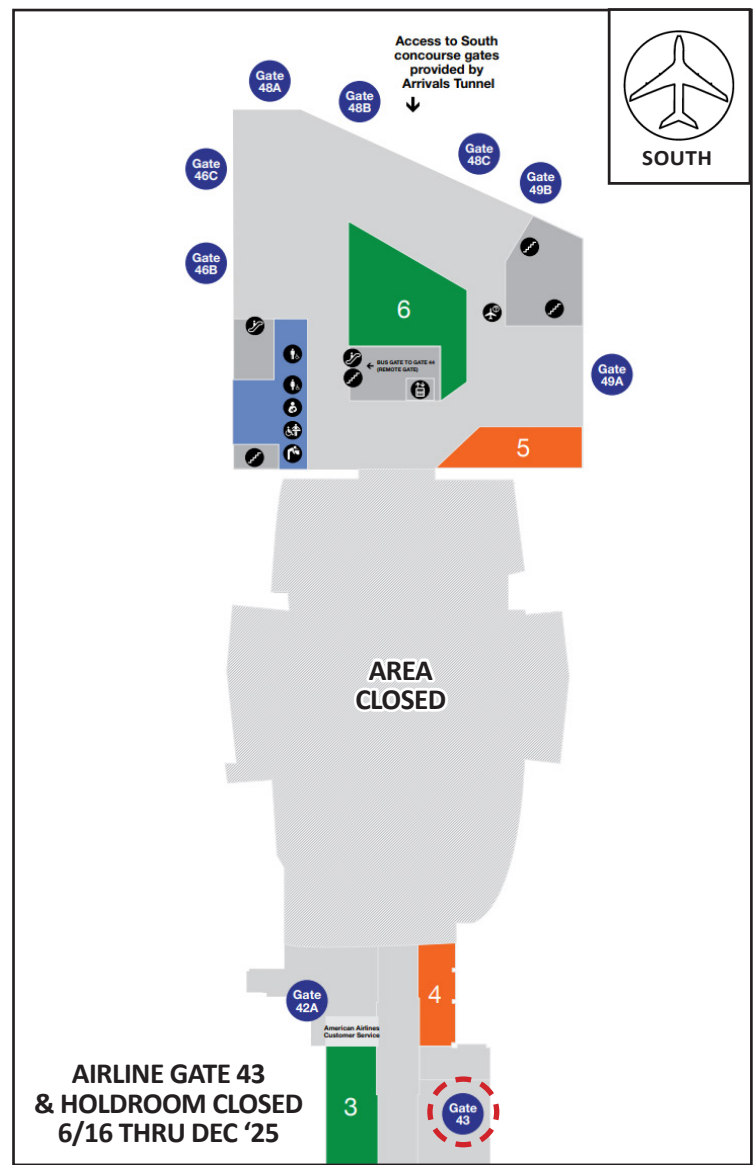

## TERMINAL 4: AIRLINE GATE OPENINGS & CLOSURES

To facilitate construction as part of the American Airlines Modernization Program, Airline Gate 43 and the adjacent holdroom are scheduled to be closed effective today, Monday, June 16 through December 2025 for holdroom renovations. Construction barricades will be installed along with signage alerting guests of alternative routes and nearby facilities.

Additionally, a reminder that the central portion of the Terminal 4 Concourse remains closed for construction with guests accessing south gates via the underground Arrivals Tunnel.

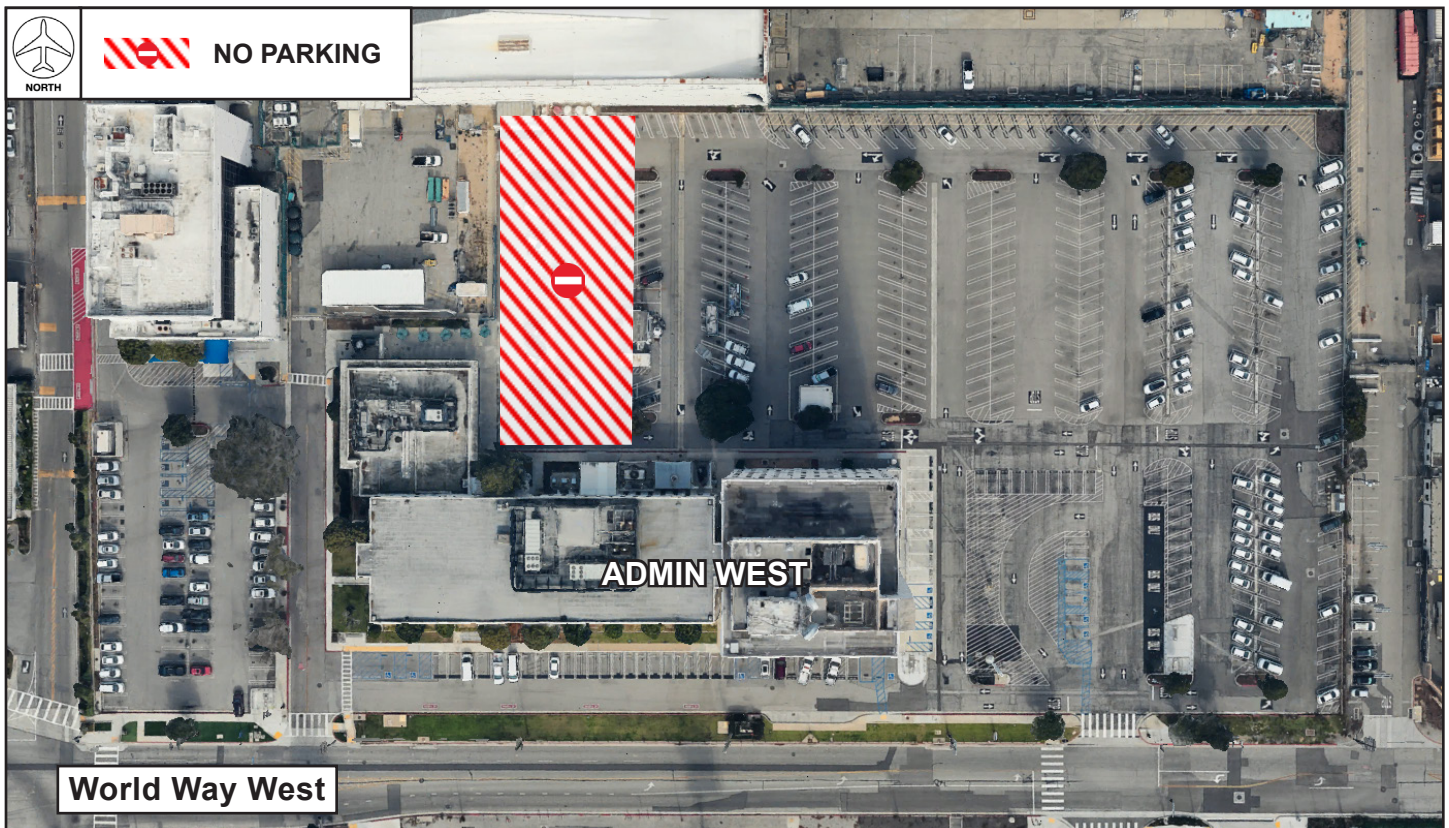

### ADMIN WEST PARKING LOT IMPACTS

To facilitate FedEx Hangar Fire Water Cut & Cap work, a portion of parking stalls at the northwest corner of the Admin West Parking Lot will be closed Monday, June 16 through Friday, July 11. While work will only be performed during daytime hours, impacted stalls will be closed 24/7.

Ingress to and egress from the lot will be maintained at all times, as well as circulation throughout the lot. If needed, additional parking is available at the lot south of World Way West.

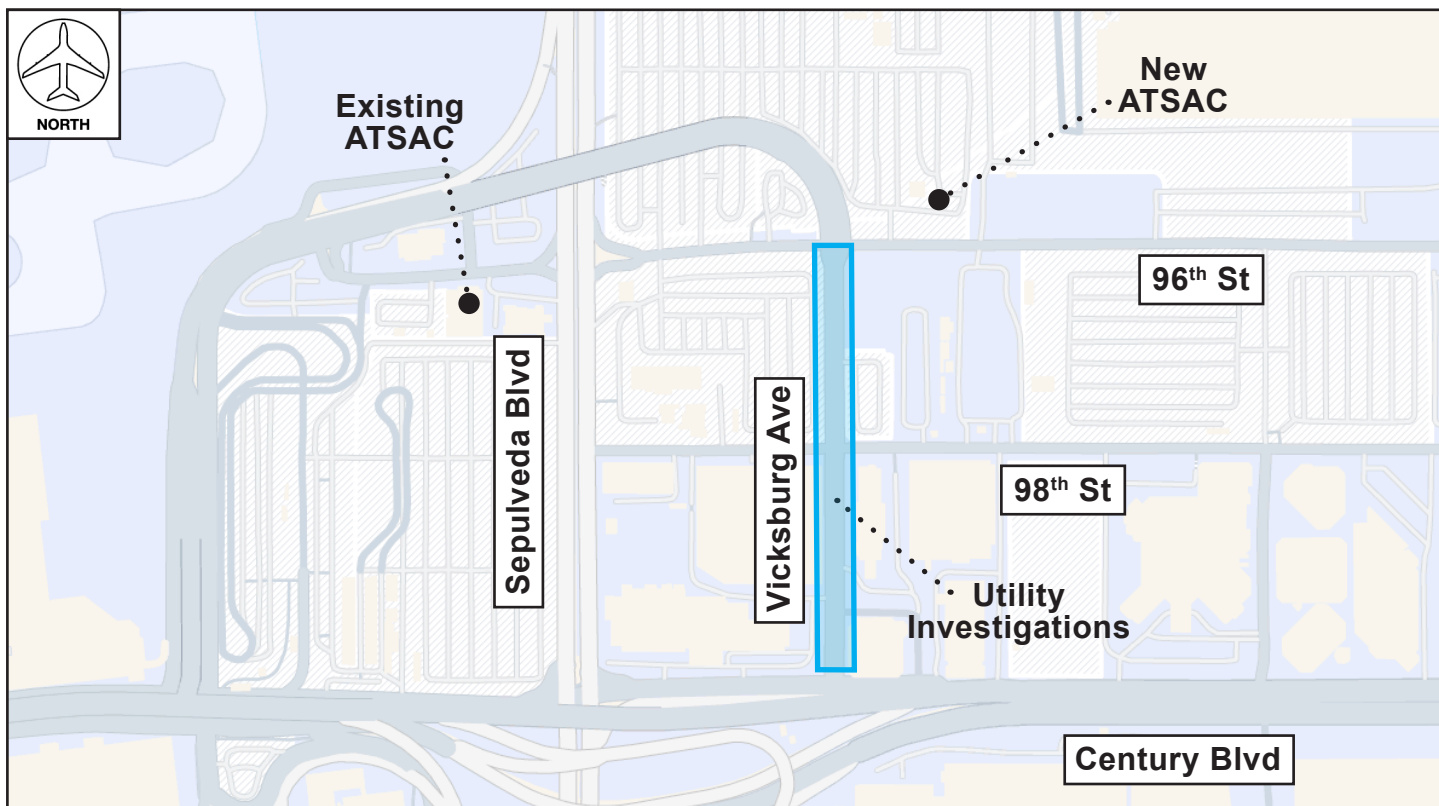

### VICKSBURG AVENUE UTILITY INVESTIGATIONS

To facilitate utility investigations for the Advanced Transportation System and Coordination (ATSAC) Hub Replacement Project, minor lane restrictions will be in place on Vicksburg Avenue between 98<sup>th</sup> Street and Century Boulevard starting June 11 through July 4 (anticipated schedule). Utility investigations will eventually progress to Century Boulevard and Sepulveda Boulevard; watch Construction Hot Topics for updates on this project and associated impacts.



This project enables the construction of a new ATSAC Hub to replace the existing hub located in the old Airport Police Headquarters, which must be demolished to facilitate work for the Airfield and Terminal Modernization Project (ATMP) and other construction at LAX. The ATSAC Hub supports traffic signals throughout the LAX campus and surrounding roadways and is owned and operated by LADOT, with LAWA facilitating the relocation of the hub.

## JUNE 2025: 24/7 CTA LANE RESTRICTIONS

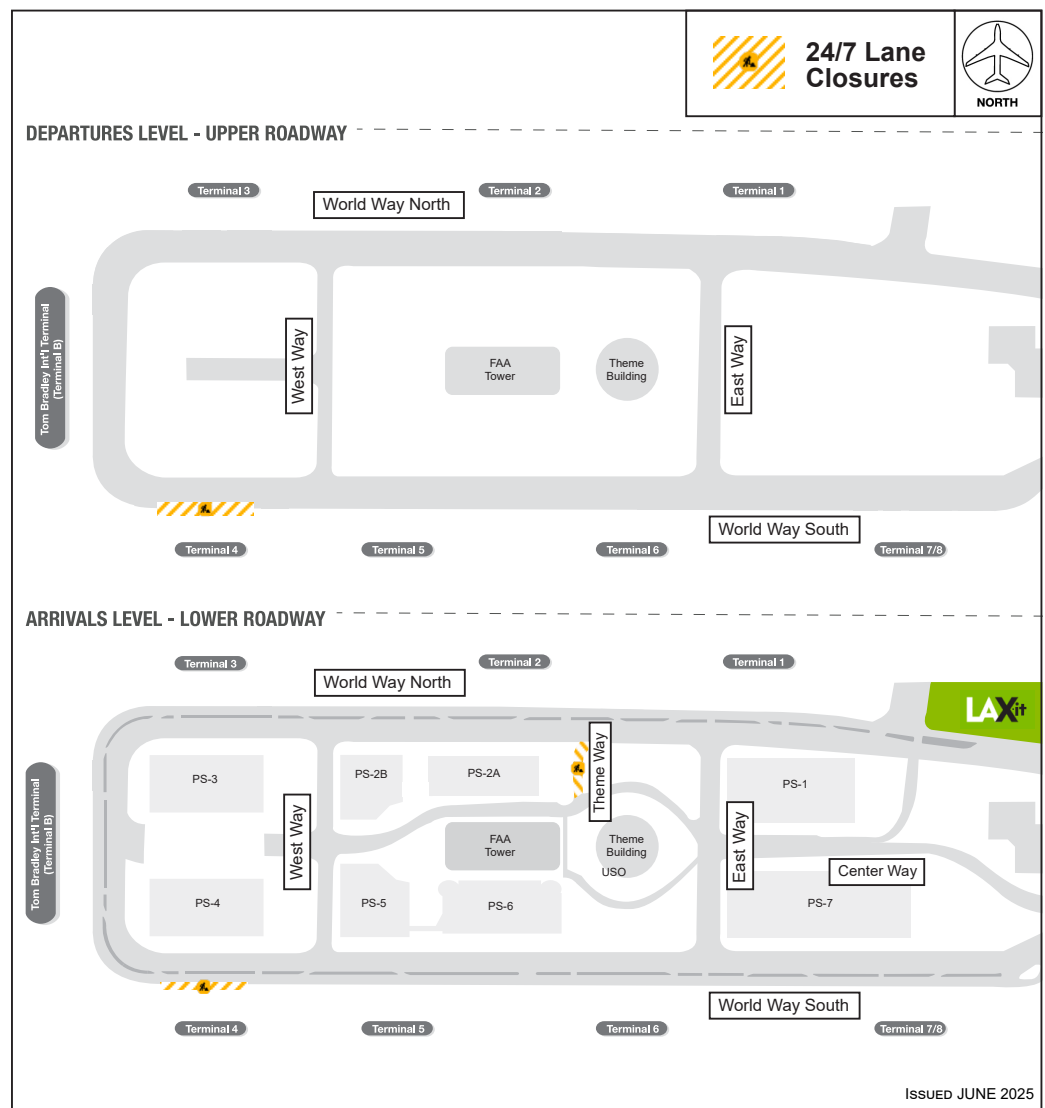
Here is a collective snapshot of scheduled 24/7 lane restrictions for CTA Departures and Arrivals Level Roadways for the month of June 2025.

This map only reflects 24/7 continuous lane closures in the CTA; nightly lane / sidewalk restrictions may be in place to facilitate construction activities.

Traffic around the Central Terminal Area will be maintained at all times, as well as access to passenger pick-up and drop-off and ingress to / egress from parking structures.

Motorists should plan ahead for potential delays and use caution when traveling near construction areas.
