Northbound and southbound traffic will be maintained at all times while up to two lanes in one direction are closed each night.







ATMP CAST-IN-DRILLED-HOLE TEST PILE PROGRAM

To facilitate work for the Airfield and Terminal Modernization Project (ATMP), please be advised that Cast-In-Drilled-Hole (CIDH) test piles will be constructed and tested at three sites; construction is scheduled for June 2 through June 30, with testing occurring through July 18. Construction fencing and Environmental Best Management Practices will be installed at all three sites June 2 through June 6. Anticipated impacts include increased noise levels and construction vehicles hauling excavated soils between sites during the construction phase; there will be no impact to the public during testing. Please use caution when traveling near construction areas.

JUNE 2025: 24/7 CTA LANE RESTRICTIONS

Here is a collective snapshot of scheduled 24/7 lane restrictions for CTA Departures and Arrivals Level Roadways for the month of June 2025.

This map only reflects 24/7 continuous lane closures in the CTA; nightly lane / sidewalk restrictions may be in place to facilitate construction activities.

Traffic around the Central Terminal Area will be maintained at all times, as well as access to passenger pick-up and drop-off and ingress to / egress from parking structures.

Motorists should plan ahead for potential delays and use caution when traveling near construction areas.
