










ADMIN WEST PARKING LOT IMPACTS

As a reminder, a portion of parking stalls at the northwest corner of the Admin West Parking Lot will be closed through Friday, July 11 to facilitate work for the FedEx Hangar Fire Water Cut & Cap Project.

While work will only be performed during daytime hours, impacted stalls will be closed 24/7. Ingress and egress will be maintained at all times, as well as circulation throughout the lot. If needed, additional parking is available at the lot south of World Way West.

Please plan ahead for potential delays and always use caution when traveling near construction areas.














PARK ONE PARKING LOT IMPACTS

To facilitate the decommissioning and abandonment of monitoring wells in Park One (former Park N' Fly lot including portions of LAX-it), please be advised that parking stall restrictions will be in place at select locations in Park One through June 30, 2025.

All work will occur during nighttime hours between 10PM and 6AM, with no work on weekends. Although work is limited to nighttime hours, impacted parking stalls will remain closed 24/7 to ensure safe access for crews and equipment.

Please plan ahead for potential delays, watch for posted "No Parking" and other construction signage, and always use caution when traveling near construction areas.









JUNE 2025: 24/7 CTA LANE RESTRICTIONS

Here is a collective snapshot of scheduled 24/7 lane restrictions for CTA Departures and Arrivals Level Roadways for the month of June 2025.

This map only reflects 24/7 continuous lane closures in the CTA; nightly lane / sidewalk restrictions may be in place to facilitate construction activities.

Traffic around the Central Terminal Area will be maintained at all times, as well as access to passenger pick-up and drop-off and ingress to / egress from parking structures.

Motorists should plan ahead for potential delays and use caution when traveling near construction areas.
