


CONSTRUCTION HOT TOPICS

#1 TERMINAL B: NEW CONSTRUCTION BARRICADES

To facilitate construction of the new Chase Sapphire Lounge in Terminal B near Gate 148 and the Gateway Tunnel to the West Gates at Tom Bradley, construction barricades are being installed on Level 4 (area pictured below). Once complete, work on the new lounge will take place behind these barricades to minimize disruption to the traveling public. #2 TERMINAL B: NEW INTERACTIVE KIOSK MONITORS

Last week, crews worked to replace the touchscreen monitors on 13 Interactive Kiosks throughout Terminal B, including in the Gateway Tunnel and West Gates at Tom Bradley. The interactive kiosks provide guests with information about airline and gate locations, nearby retail and concession options, and answers to common questions like where the closest restrooms, water refill stations and pet relief areas are.








#3 PARK ONE PARKING LOT IMPACTS COMPLETE

#4 JULY 2025: 24/7 CTA LANE RESTRICTIONS

Here is a collective snapshot of scheduled 24/7 lane restrictions for CTA Departures and Arrivals Level Roadways for the month of July 2025.

This map only reflects 24/7 continuous lane closures in the CTA; nightly lane / sidewalk restrictions may be in place to facilitate construction activities.

Traffic around the Central Terminal Area will be maintained at all times, as well as access to passenger pick-up and drop-off and ingress to / egress from parking structures.

Motorists should plan ahead for potential delays and use caution when traveling near construction areas.
