


JETWAY BOULEVARD LANE RESTRICTIONS: JULY 21 - 24

To facilitate work by the Roadway & Utility Enabling Project, lane restrictions will be in place along Jetway Boulevard, Westchester Parkway and 94th Street beginning Monday, July 21 at 11PM continuous through Thursday, July 24 at 6AM. While traffic movements will be maintained via open lanes, delays are anticipated due to reduced lanes at this area. Employee Lot South parkers are encouraged to use the 96th Street entrance and exit to avoid delays. Pedestrian access will also be maintained, with flaggers and signage in place to facilitate safe movements.

CONCOURSE WAY LANE RESTRICTIONS: JULY 21 - 24

To facilitate work required for the opening of 98th Street between Bellanca Avenue and La Cienega Boulevard by the Roadway & Utility Enabling Project, lane restrictions will be in place on Concourse Way between Arbor Vitae Street and Century Boulevard beginning Monday, July 21 at 9PM continuously through Thursday, July 24 at 6AM. All southbound lanes on Concourse Way will be closed. At least one northbound lane will be maintained at all times to facilitate shuttle access and rental car return for the LAX Rental Car Center. All shuttles and rental car return must access northbound Concourse Way from Century Boulevard.







PEDESTRIAN IMPACTS: CENTURY BLVD AT AVION DR

To facilitate work by the Automated People Mover Project, the sidewalk and two crosswalks at the southwest corner of the eastbound Century Boulevard and Avion Drive intersection will be closed Friday, July 25 at 10PM continuous through Monday, July 28 at 7AM. There are no impacts to vehicular traffic associated with this phase of work.

JULY 2025: 24/7 CTA LANE RESTRICTIONS

Here is a collective snapshot of scheduled 24/7 lane restrictions for CTA Departures and Arrivals Level Roadways for the month of July 2025.

This map only reflects 24/7 continuous lane closures in the CTA; nightly lane / sidewalk restrictions may be in place to facilitate construction activities.

Traffic around the Central Terminal Area will be maintained at all times, as well as access to passenger pick-up and drop-off and ingress to / egress from parking structures.

Motorists should plan ahead for potential delays and use caution when traveling near construction areas.
