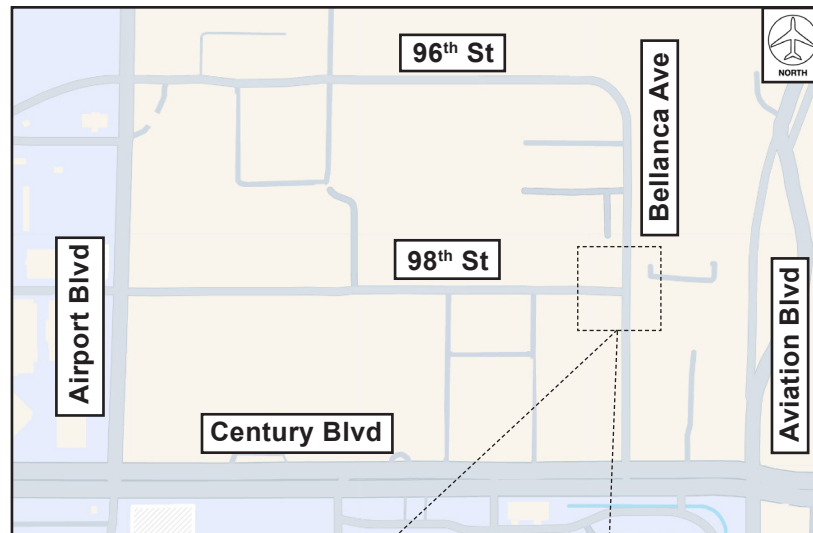

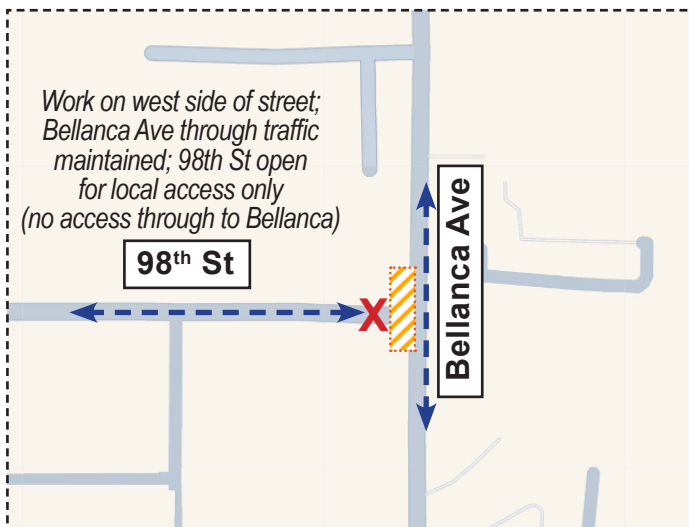

BELLANCA AVE + 98TH ST LANE RESTRICTIONS

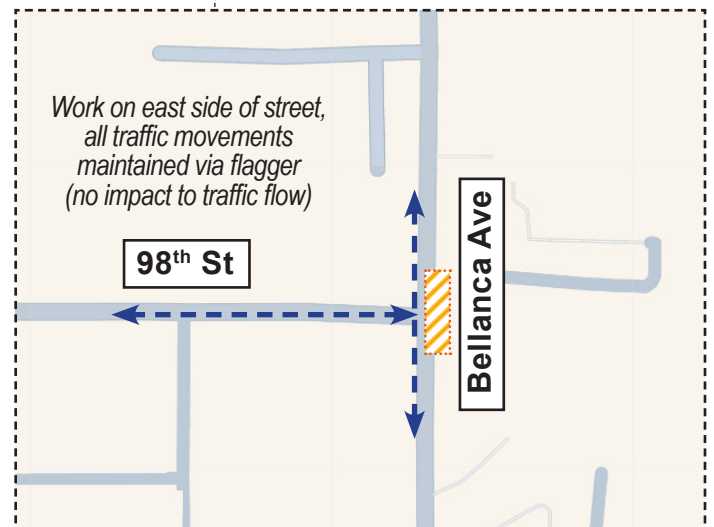
To facilitate civil work required for the opening of 98th Street between Bellanca Avenue and La Cienega Boulevard by the Roadway & Utility Enabling Project, lane restrictions will be in place at the intersection of Bellanca Avenue and 98th Street beginning Friday, July 11 at 9PM through Monday, July 14 at 6AM. Local access will be maintained at all times and signage will be in place to facilitate traffic.

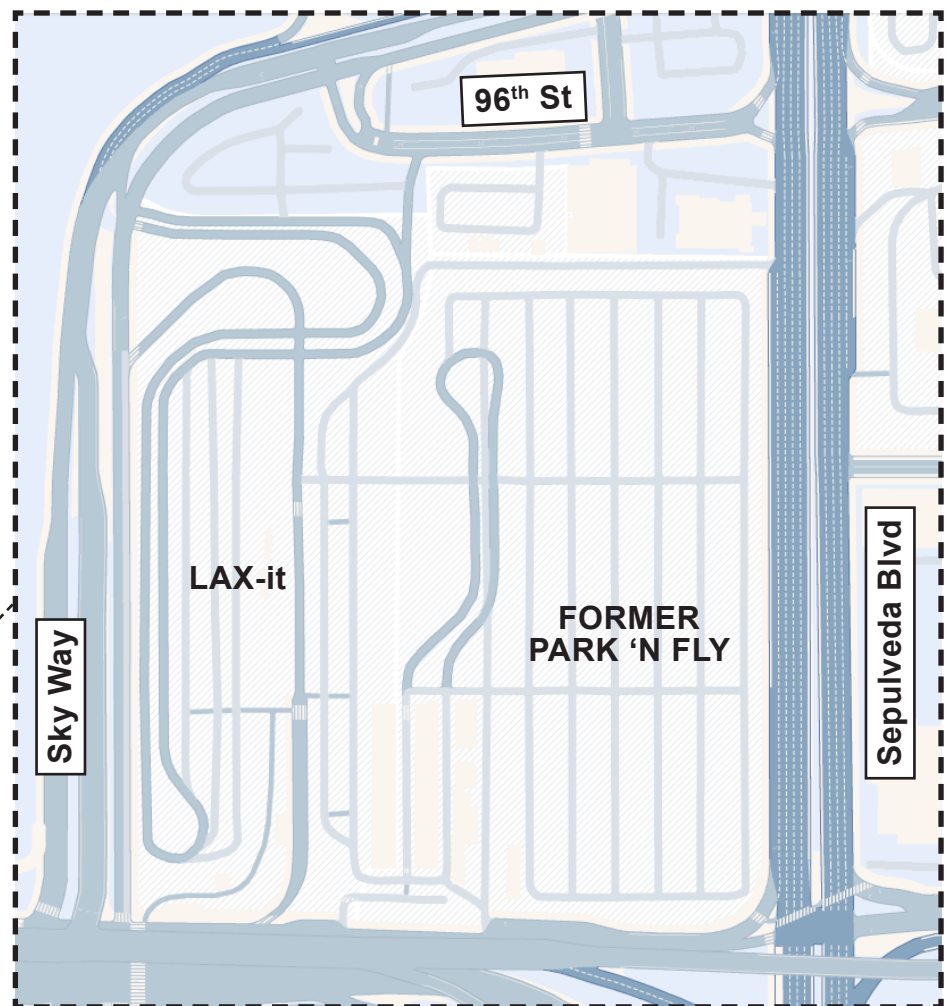

PARK ONE PARKING LOT IMPACTS - EXTENDED

To facilitate the decommissioning and abandonment of monitoring wells in Park One (former Park N' Fly lot including portions of LAX-it), please be advised that parking stall restrictions will remain in place at select locations in Park One through July 31, 2025.

All work will occur during nighttime hours between 10PM and 6AM, with no work on weekends. Although work is limited to nighttime hours, impacted parking stalls will remain closed 24/7 to ensure safe access for crews and equipment.

Please plan ahead for potential delays, watch for posted "No Parking" and other construction signage, and always use caution when traveling near construction areas.

JULY 2025: 24/7 CTA LANE RESTRICTIONS

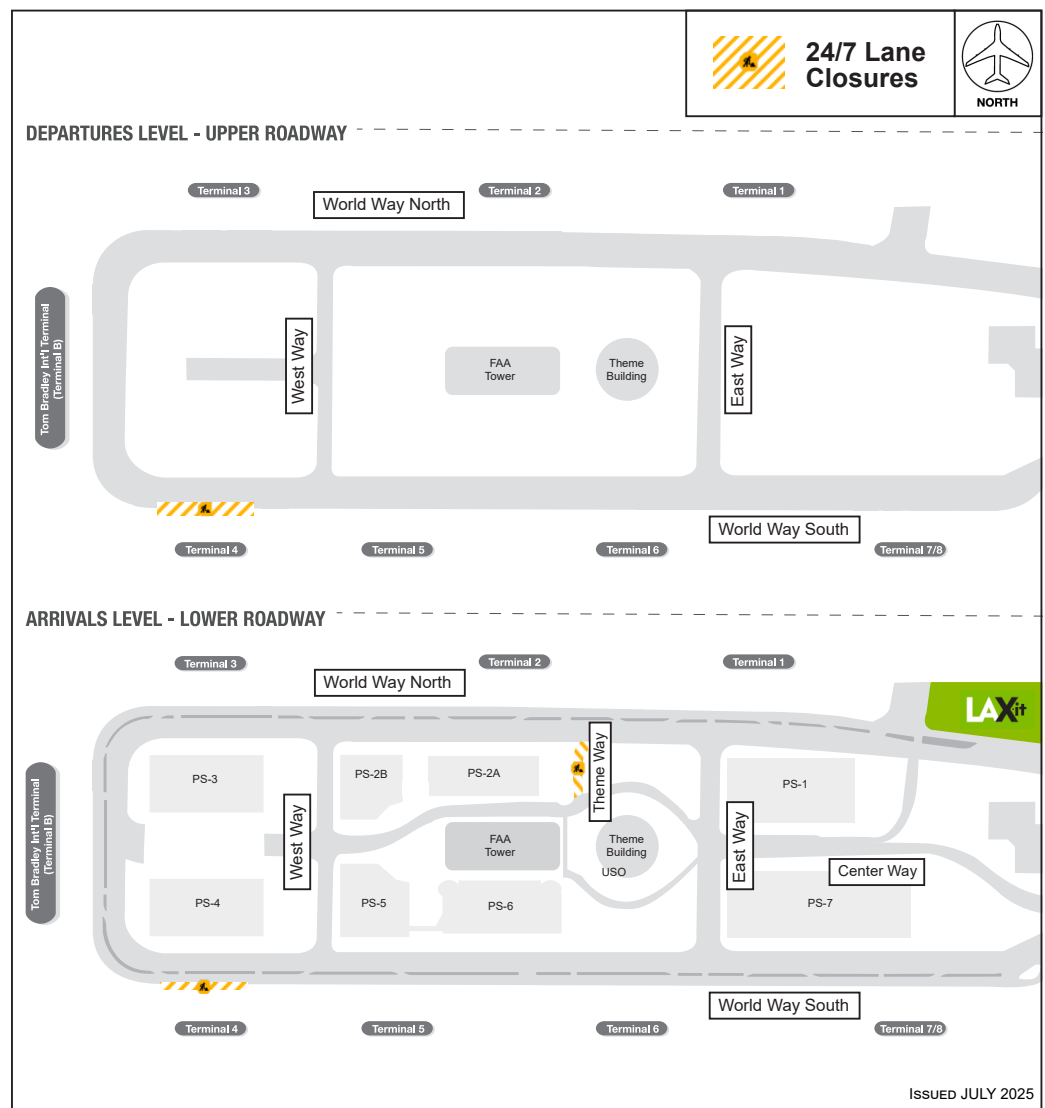
Here is a collective snapshot of scheduled 24/7 lane restrictions for CTA Departures and Arrivals Level Roadways for the month of July 2025.

This map only reflects 24/7 continuous lane closures in the CTA; nightly lane / sidewalk restrictions may be in place to facilitate construction activities.

Traffic around the Central Terminal Area will be maintained at all times, as well as access to passenger pick-up and drop-off and ingress to / egress from parking structures.

Motorists should plan ahead for potential delays and use caution when traveling near construction areas.
