




NEW STREET: 98TH ST EXTENSION OPEN TO PUBLIC

The extension of 98th Street is complete and now open to the public! 98th Street now runs continuously from La Cienega Boulevard to Sepulveda Boulevard, offering an alternative east-west route parallel to Century Boulevard. The 1.5-mile corridor includes new intersections at Bellanca Avenue, Aviation Boulevard, and Concourse Way, along with upgraded sidewalks and landscaping.

The opening of the 98th Street extension comes just weeks after the opening of Jetway Boulevard, a new north-south connector between Century Boulevard and Westchester Parkway.










LANE RESTRICTIONS: AIRPORT BLVD UTILITY WORK

Nightly lane restrictions will be in place along Airport Boulevard between Arbor Vitae Street and 96th Place, and at times portions of Arbor Vitae Street and 93th Street, beginning Saturday, August 9 through Thursday, September 25 (work hours: 9PM - 6AM). Work will occur in phases, with occasional nightly directional full closures (northbound or southbound only) between Arbor Vitae Street and 96th Street. Access to local businesses will remain open; please follow posted signs, use caution near construction areas, and plan for possible delays.









LANE RESTRICTIONS: CENTURY BLVD RESTORATION

To facilitate roadway restoration as part of the Automated People Mover Project, lane restrictions are scheduled on both east- and westbound lanes of Century Boulevard near Avion Drive this weekend: Friday, August 15 at 10PM through Monday, August 18 at 6AM.

Only one direction of Century Boulevard will be restricted at a time, and at least one lane of traffic will be maintained in that direction while work occurs. Flaggers will also be in place to facilitate traffic; please plan ahead for potential delays.

AUGUST 2025: 24/7 CTA LANE RESTRICTIONS

Here is a collective snapshot of scheduled 24/7 lane restrictions for CTA Departures and Arrivals Level Roadways for the month of August 2025.

This map only reflects 24/7 continuous lane closures in the CTA; nightly lane / sidewalk restrictions may be in place to facilitate construction activities.

Traffic around the Central Terminal Area will be maintained at all times. as well as access to passenger pick-up and drop-off and ingress to/ egress from parking structures.

Motorists should plan ahead for potential delays and use caution when traveling near construction areas.
