LAX received the "Excellence in Concrete Award" presented annually by the Southern California chapter of American Concrete Institute for exceptional environmental usage of concrete on the LAX Crossfield Taxiway Project. Part of this project entails a new 1,600-space parking lot to accommodate airline tenants displaced by the new taxiway. The use of "pervious concrete" in the construction of the parking lot allows storm water to flow through, reduces runoff from the parking lot, and helps replenish water tables and aquifers.
