

## 1. Terminal 4.5: Vertical Core Construction Update

- Construction continues as part of the Terminal 4.5 Terminal Cores and APM Interface project, with a temporary pedestrian walkway in place on the Departures Level to detour guests around construction and structural steel erection progressing airside
- Scheduled for completion in late 2022, the Terminal 4.5 building will feature new check-in areas and TSA checkpoint lanes, and a pedestrian bridge that connects to the APM's West Station




*Departures Level temporary pedestrian walkway between Terminals 4 and 5*





## 2. Terminal 3: Pedestrian Bridge Demolition Complete

- Work to demolish and remove the pedestrian bridge connecting Terminal 3 and Parking Structure 3 was completed late last week as part of the Automated People Mover project
- Terminal 3 remains closed to the public as additional construction continues both curbside and inside the terminal as part of the Delta Sky Way project




Terminal 3 / Parking Structure 3

## 3. Construction Milestone: Terminal 2 / 3 “Topping Out”

- A major construction milestone was recently reached by the Delta Sky Way project team as the final structural beam was lifted into place during last week’s “Topping Out” ceremony
- The Delta Sky Way project at LAX includes the new Terminal 2 / 3 headhouse, which will feature additional check-in areas, TSA checkpoint lanes and baggage claim facilities, as well as major renovations to both Terminal 2 and 3 concourses
- The overall project is expected to be completed by mid-2023

## 4. LAX Holiday Moratorium

- Construction related utility and area shutdown restrictions for the LAX Thanksgiving Holiday Moratorium will go into effect beginning Friday, November 20 at 6AM through Monday, November 30 at 9PM
- Next month, another holiday construction moratorium will be in effect Friday, December 18, 2020 at 6AM through Monday, January 4, 2021 at 9PM
