

- Construction continues on the Terminal 7 Vertical Core, which will eventually connect with the Automated People Mover's East CTA Station upon completion of both projects
- Currently, escalators are being installed behind construction barricades, along with the ceiling and other interior finishes




*Terminal 7 Vertical Core



- Guests should plan ahead for parking needs and check the [FlyLAX website](#) for real-time information on parking availability






