



2. Terminal 7 / 8: Overnight Taxi Stop Closure



3. Terminal 4.5: Construction Updates

- The Terminal 4.5 Core project celebrated a major milestone with the “Topping Out” of the building late last week, marking the placement of the final structural beam
- Upon completion, the Terminal 4.5 Core will connect with the Automated People Mover’s West CTA Station and also provide vertical transportation for Terminals 4 and 5
