

- Automated People Mover construction continues at the West Station site between Parking Structures 3 and 4 in the Central Terminal Area

- Pictured right is a photo from two months ago compared to (below) a current photo of the site




APM construction at West Station site January 2021



2. Terminal 1: Airline Gate 12A Re-Opened


- Airline Gate 12A in Terminal 1 is scheduled to re-open this week, which has been closed since September 2017 due to airside construction activities for the Terminal 1.5 Program
- The passenger hold room and seating area inside the concourse is not impacted by this construction and remains open and available to guests throughout the closure




3. Parking Structure 5: Smart Parking Project

- In addition to Parking Structure 1, Parking Structure 5 will experience a reduction in available parking stalls for the ABM Smart Parking Project
- Improvements include installation of electric vehicle chargers, PGS systems and pay on foot stations, painting, resurfacing and restriping
- Signage is posted to assist with wayfinding; access to and from the structure and vertical circulation within the structure is maintained at all times
- This project will eventually be performed in all parking structures in the Central Terminal Area; watch Construction Hot Topics for updates
