

1. Terminal B: Departures Level Roadway Impact Changes


- Construction of the Terminal B Vertical Core has restricted Departures Level Drop-Off Lanes at the north end of the terminal (north knuckle closer to Terminal 3) since mid-2021
- Over the past weekend, crews worked to relocate the closures from the north to the south end of the Departures Level to facilitate the next phase of work
- These closures are scheduled to be in place through June 2023; traffic flow and passenger drop off will be maintained at all times at areas before the closure



Departures Level Drop-Off Lanes at Terminal B are now restricted at the south end of the terminal

2. Terminal 3: Pedestrian Bridge

- Construction of the Pedestrian Bridge connecting Terminal 3 to the APM's West Station continues this week with nightly restrictions and / or full closures through February 19, 2022
- Detour and temporary wayfinding signage, along with flaggers, are in place to maintain traffic and pedestrian flow during construction
- Pictured below, a portion of steel trusses forming the structure of the bridge have been successfully installed with the remaining pieces to be installed this week



3. Super Bowl & Construction Moratoriums

- The 2022 Super Bowl will be held in Los Angeles on Sunday, February 13
- To accommodate the increase in passenger and vehicular traffic, a Construction Moratorium will be in effect Thursday, February 10 at 6AM through Tuesday, February 15 at 6AM, limiting the types of impactful construction activity that can be performed during this time
