


1. Super Bowl Week at LAX!

- Super Bowl LVI will bring increased pedestrian and vehicular traffic through LAX as the big game is set to be played in Los Angeles on Sunday, February 13
- A Construction Moratorium will be in place February 10 –
 February 15 to accommodate this influx of passengers;
 while some construction activity has been pre-approved
 to continue during this time, certain activity with high
 impact to the traveling public will be limited

2. Terminal 4.5 Core: Construction Update

- The Terminal 4.5 Core Project continues to make progress on the future connector building between Terminals 4 and 5; upon completion, the Terminal 4.5 Core will provide vertical transportation for Terminals 4 and 5, as well as a connection to the APM's West CTA Station
- Once the Super Bowl Construction Moratorium is complete, the east portion of the Terminal 4
 Ticketing (Departures Level) and Bag Claim (Arrivals Level) areas will close for demolition and
 future construction activities; to facilitate this work, some ticketing counters were previously
 relocated to the west portion of the terminal
- Inner roadway lanes remain restricted on both levels as they are used as temporary pedestrian walkways to guide passengers around construction; traffic and passenger drop-off / pick-up is maintained at all times
