


1. Terminal 5.5 Pedestrian Bridge: Terminal 5 Rental Car Relocation

- The APM project is constructing a Pedestrian Bridge over the roadways between Terminals 5 and 6 to connect the APM's Center CTA Station with the Terminal 5.5 Vertical Core
- To assist with the 24/7 maintenance of traffic, the Terminal 5 Rental Car Shuttle Stop located between Outer Lane Columns 5D and 5F has been relocated to the west between Columns 4J and 5B (co-located with existing Shared Ride Van Stop) through Wednesday, May 25
- This is a new change and in addition to the nightly relocation of the Terminal 6 / 7 Rental Car Shuttle to the Inner Lanes that was in previous Construction Hot Topics
- Signage and flaggers will be in place to assist with vehicular and pedestrian wayfinding




2. Terminal 4: Airline Gate Openings & Closures

- Airline Gates 47A & 47B, which have been closed since January 2022, are scheduled to re-open this week on Wednesday, April 27
- Additionally, Airline Gates 46B, 46C, 48A, 48B, 49A & 49B are scheduled to close this week on Friday, April 29 and re-open on Sunday, August 7, 2022



3. Restrictions to “Little Century” (Park One Access)

- The Los Angeles Department of Water & Power will restrict lanes at the intersection of Sepulveda and Century Boulevard nightly this week between 9PM and 5AM
- All traffic on westbound Century Boulevard must turn right to northbound Sepulveda Boulevard; traffic will not be able to continue west to cross the intersection to “Little Century” (Park One / LAX-it) or turn left to southbound Sepulveda Boulevard
- From northbound Sepulveda, vehicles may use Vicksburg Avenue to reach the Skyway Bridge, then 96th Street to reach southbound Sepulveda Boulevard, where access to “Little Century” is maintained
- Northbound and southbound through traffic on Sepulveda Boulevard is maintained at all times, with some lanes restricted on the southbound side
