1. Terminal 2 / 3: Project Update

- Construction continues on the Delta Sky Way Program to modernize Terminals 2 and 3
- Part of this modernization includes a secure connection between Terminal 3 and Tom Bradley International Terminal, pictured below, which will allow passengers to go between terminals without having to be screened again by TSA
- Once complete, passengers will be able to walk from Terminal 1 to Terminal 8 behind security
- Additionally, a portion of Departures and Arrivals Level lanes and sidewalks are closed to facilitate construction in front of Terminals 2 and 3; guests should watch for posted wayfinding and detour signage to safely navigate around closed areas


Approximately eight months of progress can be seen between aerials of the Delta Sky Way Project taken May 2022 and January 2023

2. Sepulveda Boulevard Tunnel Impacts


- Following last week's successful quarterly cleaning, the Sepulveda Tunnel will experience nightly lane restrictions beginning next week through mid-February for the City of Los Angeles Bureau of Street Services' Fire Detection Upgrade Project
- Work will close either the inner two lanes or outer two lanes on each side of the Tunnel between 11PM and 5AM
- One lane of through traffic in both directions will be maintained at all times
- Please plan ahead for potential delays and always use caution when traveling near work areas



The LA BSS Fire Detection Upgrade Project will restrict some lanes of the Sepulveda Tunnel overnight through mid-February



3. Nightly Directional Closure: Eastbound Arbor Vitae Street


- To facilitate the installation of an LADWP water line, the Consolidated Rent-A-Car (ConRAC) facility project will close all eastbound lanes on Arbor Vitae Street between Bellanca Avenue and Aviation Boulevard now through March 3, nightly from 8PM to 6AM
- Eastbound traffic will be detoured to Bellanca Avenue. Westbound through traffic and access to local businesses will be maintained



Eastbound lanes on Arbor Vitae Street will be restricted nightly through early March for work by LADWP and ConRAC


