

1. Southbound I-405 On and Off Ramp Impacts

- Work for the Landside Access Modernization Program (LAMP) will impact southbound I-405 ramps at Century Boulevard (West and East) beginning Friday, June 9 at 11PM, continuously (through the weekend) until Sunday, June 11 at 6AM:
- West Ramp: Both Off and On Ramps closed (including collector distributor road)
- East Ramp: Off Ramp closed; On Ramp remains open
- On and off ramps will be reduced down to one lane each for approximately six months
- Detour signage will be in place
- Travelers should use caution when navigating these areas as new roadway conditions will be implemented

Travelers using SB I-405 to reach LAX may experience delays as ramp restrictions take place this weekend for work by the LAMP project

2. Now Open! Terminal 3 West Headhouse

- The new West Headhouse at Terminal 3 is now officially open to the traveling public
- This milestone marks the completion of the second to last major phase of construction before the Delta Sky Way project opens to the public later this year
- On the Departures Level, the new facility features self-service kiosks for passenger check-in and bag drop, as well as an additional entry point to access check-in security areas
- On the Arrivals Level, Delta One passengers can use the private Delta One check-in area which leads to a private TSA screening lane and direct access to the Delta Sky Club
- Other notable improvements including the addition of 100 seats to the Delta Sky Club, the reopening of the Terminal 3 passenger tunnel with direct access to baggage claim, a larger Help
 Center and direct connection to the LAX Automate People Mover (when the train opens in
 2024)



3. Consolidated Rent-A-Car (ConRAC) Project to Install Intersection Traffic Signals

- Lanes on Arbor Vitae Street between Bellanca Avenue and La Cienega Boulevard will be restricted through August 31, 2023 while the ConRAC project installs traffic signals
- Work will occur Monday through Friday from 9AM to 3:30PM and 8PM to 8AM, and Saturdays from 8AM to 6PM
- Through traffic and access to local businesses will be maintained at all times
